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REVENUE: Notes and Assumptions

- 1 Municipal: Request \$250,000 from the Town of Cobourg
- 2 Provincial: Apply for exhibition grant. We have been encouraged by Ontario Arts Council to apply \$15,000; Apply for a Ontario Trillium Foundation (OTF) to support art education programs \$55,000. Our pilot projects have demonstrated the need.
- 3 Federal: Apply for 2 summer students; both pursuing studies in Fine Art or Education
- 4 Miscellaneous Grants: Identify and Apply Northumberland County and municipal funding opportunities; Apply to the Elizabeth L. Gordon Art Program through the Ontario Arts Foundation (OAF)
- 5 Sponsorships receive advertisement in return for donation.
- 6 Donations are gifts received in kind or cash and donor is given a tax receipt.
- 7 AGN Services: Rental facilities Program; Fundraising: AGN Spotlight Series II; AGN Art Bus
- 8 The Shop on 3: Commission (there is no expense line, all expenses to operate shop are nominal and charge to office supplies)
- 9 Membership Fees: funds earned through membership to the AGN, new or renewl; Corporate Memberships launch
- 10 Education Programs: no increase in revenue due to determine optimization of programs and staffing (stabilizing the business)
- 11 Interest and other income: OAF interest; donation box.

- 13 Office and Sundry: Office supplies, postage, miscellaneous cards, gifts; meeting expenses.
- 14 Furniture and Equipment: Reception chairs and museum stools
- 15 Rent: exchange of cheques with Town of Cobourg.
- 16 Insurance: Art/Liability/Directors and Officers
- 17 Security Charges: Paid to the Town of Cobourg: weekend and evenings
- 18 Repairs and Maintenance: Replacement of the Floor: \$40,000; Cleaning contract: \$2,500
- 19 Bank and Merchant fees: Royal Bank; TD; VISA/MasterCard/Debit Terminal
- 20 Marketing and Communications: recommended Executive Director Cell Phone: \$1,200; Social Media; Ads; Print: \$5,800

- 24 Exhibitions: 6 Exhibitions in Main Gallery: \$30,000 (\$5,000 per show); 6 Exhibitions in PC Gallery: \$21,000 (\$3,500 per show) Includes Installation fees; Transportation fees, Artists fees, Curatorial fees, Publication and Research fees, Opening Reception fees, Performance fees.
- 25 AGN Services / Fundraising: expenses related to services or fundraising activities
