

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT | January 17, 2021

Museums are governed, managed and operated by people -- social institutions in which people work together to achieve and sustain the mission, mandate, goals and objectives. The AGN has three major departments: Administration, Public Programs/Education and Curatorial.

ADMINISTRATION

<u>Human Resources:</u> We welcome Avery Gebores and Erin Messier to our team as Education Assistants working directly with programing within the Permanent Collection. Both these positions are funded through Canada Museums Association through the Young Canada Works program. All staff are currently working from home on specific projects.

Victoria Towrie's employment contract ended December 31, 2020, we have suspended the renewal of this contract until late spring. This was a mutual decision and we look forward to working with Victoria later this year.

We continue with weekly review of staff compensation; monitoring industry trends and recommendations; adhering to Government compliance as a result of COVID-19.

<u>Facility</u>: Weekly checks are conducted in Gallery spaces, vault and storage room. Victoria Hall remains closed until further notice. Town of Cobourg staff have provided support and regular updates.

Finance: We are in the process of applying for two federal grants, and continue to look for funding opportunities.

CURATORIAL


We have submitted the Ron Bolt painting *Primal Pool Atlantic* for Cultural Property designation and look forward to a positive response by end of March.
