- Florist, one bouquet designed with seasonal flowers and one boutonniere.
- Violinist, one hour of time, some consulting for requested songs.
- Catering, 3-4 appetizers for 25 guests. Beverages are not included.
- Vendors are from the community.
- Note: Washrooms are located on the lower level of Victoria Hall. The building is wheelchair accessible. The wedding occurs in the gallery only.


